Important and rare pair of painted sheet metal cones vases dating from the empire period and painted myhtological scene.

be careful, these are hand-painted scenes, real paintings, they are not enhanced engravings or chromolithographies!

these large cornet vases are very decorative and the decorations are different on each side, the colors used are beautiful, we see goddesses or nymphs occupied near a fountain, in wooded landscapes, cupids wearing wreaths and flowers. Butterfly wings or fairy wings, one of the scenes represents the story of "Psyche and Love" ... the whole is charming and each vase rests on 4 claw feet in gold-plated metal, all resting on the basics square decorated with false marbles. nside each cornet vase are the original zinc

interiors that have been preserved and saved despite corrosion.

of course, these two vases have been restored from corrosion on the metal, and they are stabilized, however we do not recommend using them with water like a glass vase, the humidity could again alter them.

It is rare today to meet such beautiful hand-painted and almost perfect-looking cone-shaped vases, their large size make them quality vases, very rare and very decorative rare objects.
