According to Paul Louis Cyfflé (1724-1806), a figurine made of pipe earthenware representing an allegory of winter. Remarkable delicacy of features, this statuette represents a naked man, covered just with a stole, protecting himself from the cold and trying to warm himself with a firepot. Original work of Paul Louis Cyfflé, realized here by Toul Bellevue's faïencerie under the period of Jules Aubry 1860-1898. The man's fingers are missing over the firepot. Delivery 14 euros in France, 25 euros in the EU and 35 euros rest of the world.
