Description

Original pencil drawing on laid paper with a watermark, depicting four studies of young girls, treated as studies of attitudes and movements. The sheet brings together several poses observed from life: a girl standing in profile, as well as various natural attitudes from everyday life, drawn with spontaneity and keen observation. The work as a whole demonstrates studio practice, characteristic of academic art at the end of the 19th and beginning of the 20th centuries, where the artist focused on capturing the accuracy of postures and proportions rather than an elaborate narrative scene. The sheet bears the studio stamp "Atelier O.R." surmounted by a crown in the lower right corner, attesting to its origin. Antique laid paper with a legible watermark.
