Sweet ticket forming lady secretary in speckled cuba mahogany, mark of boxwood nets, resting on a base with two skates on wheels, joined by a double baluster rail. The mobile top revealing a lemon plating locker with a secret opening, front and back facades garnished with yellow silk decorated with laurel wreaths and bees. The flap lined with green leather gilded iron, discovering a writing kit in two swivel lockers (inkwell, pen holder and scraper) and a scribed mobile mail range, all in lemon plating. The bottom is lined with a dark green pleated silk. Lock in operation with his key. Good general condition Size: Height 113 cm Width 57 cm Work of the early nineteenth century; The soft note is a small piece of office furniture for occasional correspondence. Generally it consists of a high base supporting a
