



Auguste Coomans (1855-1896) Sheep, Sheepdog And Her Resting Dog, Oil / Panel



Description

Important landscape featuring a group of sheep under the supervision of a shepherdess and her dog at rest. Signed by the Belgian animal painter, Auguste Coomans. The sheep subject, dear to Coomans, is treated with delicacy and realism. Here a large group with lambs is represented, in the first but also in the background, within a landscape perspective with depth; a subtle palette of greens, the stop of the landscape carved by the sky, accentuates the topography as the mystery of its situation: do sheep graze on the edge of a cliff, on lush hills, mountains or seaside? The sky,

worked, poetic mirror to this bucolic scene, also has relief.

The shepherd rests, seizing this suspended time. Beautiful framing.
