René Chancrin was born April 2, 1911 in Villeurbanne. After studying at the Vincentians, he entered the School of Fine Arts in Lyon in 1927. He benefited from the teaching of Auguste Morizot and Jacques Laplace. From 1928, he exhibited regularly at the Salon d'Automne in Lyon, and from 1931, at the Salon du Sud-Est. In 1934, he joined the group of " New " and will exhibit with them two years at the gallery Saint Pierre. From that moment, he participates in many exhibitions and especially in Paris. His activity is stopped by the war but his appointment of professor of drawing at the School of Fine Arts allows him to be demobilized Influenced by
