Beautiful old Dagestan, stocky format, this rug has a dark green background covered totally with regular rhombuses, bordered with yellow, containing stylized flowers.

Beautiful borders have almost square flowers. The rather narrow field is underlined by broad borders presenting to the left and to the right, eleven large "S" resembling "2". These symbols in the form of "S" are the transcription of the first letter of the Armenian word meaning "GOD, ALL POWERFUL", they appear further on the carpets, in all the forms of expression of the plastic arts of Armenia, and only from Armenia, we can therefore say that only Armenians have used this symbol.
