Sabre back legs ending with simple shoes. Arm support behind the leg line ; S-shape arms with acanthus leaves decor. Openwork fiddle back decorated with acanthus leaves and scrolls on the stiles and central splat adorned with openwork heart, scrolls, acanthus leaves, C-crest and cartouche. Seat upholstered with a yellow background oriental style motifs RUBELLI fabric with orange and red tones motifs.
