Arrived in France, he is naturalized and trained at the School of Fine Arts of Paris in the workshop of Brianchon from 1947 to 1950. In 1952 he is laureate of the Casa de Velázquez². He won the prize of Maison Descartes in Amsterdam in 1953. Albert Zavarro is a friend of the couple Jean Joyet and Marcelle Deloron. His son, Pascal Zavarro, is a recognized musician. Albert Zavarro teaches at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in Paris and, between 1970 and 1980, he has Nicolas Blin, Patrick
