



# Happiness-of-the-day Louis XVI Stamped Dissidi d'Après Topino



## Description

Precious bureau happiness-of-the-day marquetry period first half 20th stamped of the famous house Dissidi master cabinetmaker in Paris (see photo) furniture of the Faubourg Saint-Antoine of good quality after an eighteenth model by Charles Topino (1742-1803) having an ellipsoidal shape with an oval section and a half-moon step, the whole is inlaid on all sides in various partially polychrome precious wood veneers containing utensils, vases and floral motifs, the tray also decorated with these same decorations with variants and repeating itself on the belt and the spacer bar of kidney shape, it opens with two leaves (small missing a lock) an open locker in the center and a big drawer in belt, It rests on arched feet faceted topped with bronze falls with retained draperies; at the top a small cut-out
