The Gallery ROMANET, in Algiers, organizes in 1940 his first exhibition, He is not yet 18 years old. In 1955, the Parisian critic discovers it during his exhibition at BERNHEIM-Jeune and salutes him as a leading artist. It is at this time, with its austere landscapes, its characters a little misérabilistes and its superb portraits of all Paris, that begins what will make the celebrity of Guy
