Small crystal statuette or paperweight representing a naked young woman, model "Floreal", signed Lalique * France, on a black glass base, vintage twentieth century. This statuette is in very good condition. It is signed on the side. This is the model "Floréal", created in 1928, the cap of the large bottle n° 1 of the "Myosotis" dressing, in molded pressed white glass. Sold in paperweight in 1942, continued in 1947, taken over after 1951. (See catalog raisonné Lalique by Marcilhac). A report: tiny time wear, see photos. * René Jules Lalique (1860-1945) is a French master glassmaker and jeweler, founder of Maison Lalique. He became famous for his amazing creations of jewelry, perfume bottles, vases, candlesticks, clocks and, at the end of his life, cabochons of cars. The company he founded
