Painting treated in a post-impressionist way, with a lot of material. On chassis from Sennelier 3 quai Voltaire in Paris. Dimensions of the canvas 41x33 cm. Frame dimensions 45x37 cm. André Hofer, painter and illustrator, born in Autun [Saône-et-Loire], has been exhibiting regularly at the Salon des Indépendants since 1912. He is best known and renowned as an illustrator.
