Standing, sumptuously coiffed and nicely dressed, it is represented in a beautiful hatitude; she carries a bundle of vegetables with one hand holding it on her back by means of a rope, and the other carrying beets or others. You will note the quality of this sculpture very finely worked, you will be able to notice the richness of the details, the softness of the features of the face, the beauty of the drape of the garment etc. This statuette is in good condition, nevertheless it has small hair used in ivory, one of them concerning his hat

Additional information : Specimen ivory Elephantidae spp (I / A) pre-convention, prior to June 1, 1947 in accordance with CE Regulation 338/97 of 09/12/1996 art.2-Wmc. For an exit of the EU, a CITES of re-export will be necessary, this one being at the expense of the future purchaser. The issuance of such a document is not automatic. The future buyer will have to inquire about re-export conditions as some countries do not allow the introduction of Elephantidae ivory specimens into their territory.
