Description

Large oil on canvas depicting the funeral convoy of the Queen of France Isabeau de baviere * married to Charles VI. the original painting was painted by Jean Truchot in 1822, died in 1823, a year later a T.Rumigny painted this painting after Jean Truchot, certainly on a particular order.* Isabeau dies in the strictest indifference, abandoned by all. The funeral ceremonies are reduced to their simplest expression. His body is not brought to Saint-Denis by coach and by the Rue Saint-Denis as is the custom for the kings and queens of France. His coffin is placed in a boat that sails at night in the utmost discretion of the port Saint-Landry from Paris to Saint-Denisen following the curves of the Seine.the frame need to be restore.the painting measures a view 103 cm x 79 cm.The frame measures 125 cm x 101
