the blade is reconverted from an old dagger left hand dagger blade from the 16th century, and is named cathedral blade because of its open work and its longitudinal grooves.

The blade was mounted as a dagger / bayonet first half 19 th with system of the handle to fix on the double barrel of the shotgun.
