



# Chalice In Golden Silver And Paten In Silver, France Beginning Of XIXth Century



### Description

This chalice is entirely in gilded silver. The circular base is swollen with embossed decoration and chiseled on the edge of rosettes and smooth bands. Foot terrace adorned with a radiating cross in front of Jerusalem and plant symbols of the Eucharist. The corded, two-necked stem has an ovoid knot, adorned with palm leaves, ears of wheat, bunches of grapes and reeds. The cup is cylindrical with a slightly flared edge decorated with the same engraved plant motif. This chalice was most probably executed by a Master Goldsmith in the early 19th century. This chalice bears several incomplete or crossed out hallmarks or stamps, they cannot be identified with precision. Height: 26.5 cm
