flows, thoughtful, a mirror in her hand. Her hairstyle is embellished with lily pads. The base in black and green marble is decorated with bronze (leaves, reeds, rushes ...) supported by 2 women in the antique style.

Pair of candelabra with leaves and reed spikes, 6 lights each

Nemausa was a goddess of fertility and healing belonging to the sanctuary of the source of the same name, located near Nîmes.

According to the catalog raisonné, there are several variants including this one on a pendulum.
