The circular foot placed on a marble base (?). The mastery of these various techniques allows us to attribute this work to Dominique Denuelle- Rue de Crussol. At that time Dominique Denuelle acquired a solid reputation for his mastery of matt gilding, he was the supplier of the Duchess of Berry. Late Empire Period early Restoration Period.
