



Ewer And Its Basin, Chiseled Copper, Ottoman Empire, End Of The XIXth Century,



Description

Very beautiful model of ewer called "Ibriq" placed on its basin provided with its soap holder, originating in Turkey, Ottoman Empire of the end of the XIXth century and in superb condition. Our red copper model has a swollen belly decorated with engraved plants and has suffered visible damage on one side, a brass handle allows the grip. The basin in very good condition, presents a slight accident on the edge.

Widely decorated with foliage, it has its grid and its soap holder which receives the underside of the ibriq.

The price is corresponding to the state of the ibriq, but if you wish, you can take only the basin at the price of 490 EUR .

Ibriq, or also Ibrik (?????) in Arabic, often means a jug with a handle . During Islamic ritual
