Beautiful object, a manju button, a netsuke which was attached by the two holes to a silk cord, to retain an object at the belt. This manju, in the shape of a "rice cake" is engraved on top, in high relief, of a Shintoist scene with a priest and a character hidden under the magic cauldron ... this character, once discovered, flees at full speed on the other side of the button, this time hollowed out, (remarkable!), "sunken relief" technique).
