Description

Important bronze and marble clock representing "Diane de Poitiers" by Jean Goujeon. Rare clock model in the style of the Renaissance, NIII period. The marble base in griotte red color is carved with grooves, in the center the dial with the Roman numeral is also in marble, it is surrounded by a rich ornament in stylized bronze retained by an interlacing frieze of LXVI style. The patinated bronze subject representing Diane is removable, it bears the signature of the famous founder F. Barbedienne born August 6, 1810 in Saint-Martin-de-Fresnay and died March 21, 1892 in Paris. This bust model in the likeness of Diane de Poitiers was created by the sculptor Jean De Boulogne during the Renaissance. Note that in the price we have provided that the clock mechanism will be in working condition.
