Description

Impressive 18th-century Spanish capipote representing Saint Joseph, carved in wood with striking details. This devotional figure features realistic glass paste eyes (sulfide) and a unique touch: Saint Joseph is depicted wearing boots, an unusual detail as he is traditionally shown barefoot. His original tin lily staff, symbolizing purity and virtue, adds to the authenticity and charm of this piece.

Capipotes were used in processions and religious ceremonies, their articulated limbs and lifelike expressions designed to evoke a powerful spiritual presence. Standing at 113 cm high, this Saint Joseph capipote embodies the craftsmanship and devotional fervor of Spanish religious art of the period.
