Description

This pair of Neapolitan nativity figures, depicting Joseph and Mary, dates from the 18th century. The heads are crafted in terracotta with glass eyes, while the hands and legs are carved from wood, reflecting the exceptional craftsmanship typical of Neapolitan art of this period. The costumes, restored using antique fabrics, enhance the refinement and elegance of these figures.

Neapolitan nativity scenes, known as Presepi, became highly popular from the 17th century onwards. They are renowned for their meticulous attention to detail and lifelike expressiveness. Each figure is unique, often depicting a range of social classes and professions from daily life. The terracotta heads, hand-painted with delicate expressions, and the glass eyes add a striking
