They stand out for their elegance in their wavy shapes: the seat is supported by a wavy band and carved with rocaille elements as well as the backrest. The legs are arched and the foot carved. The armrests, curved and shaped, contribute to give a particularly harmonious line. The armchairs, which can be placed together or individually, are very decorative both in an entrance hall or in a room that in a bedroom.
