### Description

Rare pair, good condition, covered jars on pedestal, roccaille ornaments in relief outlined in purple. Decoration polychrome in low fire of a shell surrounded by foliage, in the center : a cartouche, marked for one with manganese: Sagapene: 39, and for the other: Bensoë: 22. Models close to those of the Lorrain museum. Our Pharmacy jars have all the characteristics of the 18th century, but would in fact be a reissue, made at the factory, taking over the old molds, from the time of charcoal ovens, before 1840. A good earthenware collector of Lorraine was kind enough to show me his 2 jars, which are from same hand. Dimensions = H: 31cm, D: 14cm. Condition is excellent. Obviously, these jars were almost not used: an enamel chip on the edge
