




Par Pierre Thomire à Sa Dépêche, 1784, Signé. XVIIIe

A quality character sitting in front of his library on a Louis XVI armchair, holding a letter or a dispatch; he is dressed in a burgundy velvet suit on a winter vest with rich embroidery revealing a fine lace tie that can be found at the fall of sleeves.

A thin silver buckle at the bottom of her panties underlines social well-being.

Portrait dated 1784, **signed P.Tomire for Pierre Thomire - (the family spelling of Thomire is Tomire on verified genealogical records) -,

godfather of Pierre Philippe Thomire, the bronze sculptor.

Portrait in excellent condition, lined in the 19th century.
