Description

This exquisite carved oak angel, dating from the late 16th century, is a superb example of Renaissance religious art. The angel is beautifully crafted, with intricate details in the drapery and a serene facial expression, showcasing the skill of the artist.

The figure features slots for wings at the back, indicating that it was likely part of a larger ecclesiastical setting, such as an altarpiece or a church decoration. Its dimensions--52 cm in height, 17 cm in length, and 18 cm in depth--give it a strong presence, reflecting the grandeur and elegance of the period's sacred art. Despite some
