



Office Slope Mahogany Nantes Work - Louis XVI Period



Description

Sloping Louis XVI period desk in mahogany wood opening with four drawers, two small and one large, flap decorated with a wrapped medallion decorated with bouquets of flowers in marquetry of light wood and stained wood, revealing inside 9 small espalier drawers in oak and walnut wood. Amounts and fluted legs. This piece of furniture is underlined on all its faces with a marquetry border. Pull handle and lock entry in brass and bronze with remains of gilding. This piece of furniture has a hiding place in the middle, hatch with a system opening unlocked by the sliding of the first shelf and revealing inside two bolts blocking the opening of the two drawers on each side on the front.
