Large cutlery cutlery in violin shape decorated with palmettes, fillets and shells.

The sleeves are in filled silver; the fork and its protective spatula are in solid silver: 1st grade old man's head hallmark, large hallmark hallmark, goldsmith Cardeilhac.

Adjoining coat of arms: "argent à la croix d'azur" and "d'azur strewn with golden lilies, from Gules to the silver lion (the Abbey of Près in Douay).

Maison Cardeilhac established by Antoine-Vital Cardeilhac in 1804 at 4 rue du Roule.

Hallmark of 1820 (the second) symbol: cross of the crowned legion of honor and a crescent below.
