This technique, popular at the time, added an elegant and luxurious touch while being more affordable than genuine leather.

The generous dimensions of each panel--56 cm wide by 185 cm high--allow for a total width of 2.34 meters when arranged end-to-end. In good overall condition, this screen serves as both a practical solution for dividing a space and a decorative object of great elegance.
