

Three Little School Girls' Herbaria From Nièvre And Vienne In 1932-1934



Description

Set of 3 school herbariums: 1 / Made by Elisabeth Goussot, 12 and a half, at the girls' school in Epiry, (Nièvre) in 1932 and comprising 33 sheets in a 25 X 40 format notebook with sheets of dividers in iron gray rag paper; 2 / Directed by Janine Goussot, 12 years old, in the same school the same years, composed of 33 sheets in the same presentation and the same format; 6 leaves are attacked by a greedy insect (photo). The lesson was on plant morphologies. 3 / Finally a small binder of 33 free sheets with folder -titles and labels in the bottom right indicating subject, location, (Vienna) dates (1934-35) designed by Charles Ravaud. This set teaches us about the good choices of teaching in these times when it seemed appropriate to educate the children of the plant world while allowing them to design
