About ... Alumina

The Alumina company was founded in 1862 by August Schjøtt (1834 - 1863). In 1868 the company moved to Frederiksberg. In 1882 she joined the Royal porcelain factory in Copenhagen. Production becomes industrial. The period 1901 - 1928 was a period of great success under the leadership of Chr. Joachim (1870-1943) and Harald Slott-Møller (1864-1937). Later, Nils
