

Non-standard Showcase



Description

It is in fact an astonishing large oven that can without transformation be used as a showcase, ideal for presenting scientific instruments and especially medical to stay close to its primary destination. A copper dome surmounted by a chimney flanked by two vents constitutes the top, a copper tank with an opening forms the lower part; below is a burner with several spouts. Air vents on the sides. The interior walls of the glazed part include a dozen vertical brass tubes for the circulation of heat; for the same reason, the wooden trays are perforated. The showcase is presented with two floors in place but a third tray will be provided to the buyer. A manufacturer's cartridge mentioning Doctor Roux. It was electrified without any modification or drilling with a flexible strip of LEDs. Complete, good
