Original frame, in wood (oak) and gilded beam. Frame dimensions 64 x 73 cm. Original mount, golden border. Slight spots on the bottom of the mount.

Dimensions of the engraving 34 x 43 cm. Signed above right.

Léopold Haeck (Antwerp, 1868- Wijnegem, 1928).

Belgian painter and engraver. Training at the Academy of Antwerp at C. Verlat and at the Higher Institute of Antwerp.

Debut at the Salon Triennal in 1888. Painted and engraved views of cities, genre scenes, portraits of the landscapes of Campine.

Affects twilight and chiaroscuro. Its luminous

realism is characterized by a free touch.
