### Description

Beautiful box, spotted horn, inlaid with copper nets, in the center of the lid an enameled medallion. The box is trimmed with ebony edges. Very clean champagne-colored silk interior. An inner plate contains 5 beautiful, partly gilt steel sewing instruments, including surprising openwork scissors, a pretty pewter die with decorated garland, a punch, a steel needle case, a grommet. Dimensions = 15.5cm and 9.5cm, and 6cm. Condition of box is good, with a few missing threads, the surface is slightly curled and wrinkled, but nothing serious. The steel parts were recently cleaned, the engravings underlined in cold gold.
