Both with pistol-shape handles with engraved silver mounts, in the upper part two antler scales riveted with lozenge rosettes. The top ended with an acorn. Steel blades. Reference: Similar one in the book "Cutlery from gothic to art deco" The J. Hollander Collection p. 273 n° 502. Dimension : length of case 15.5 cm/ knife 22.5 cm/fork 22.3 cm/ fusil 20.7 cm. Germany end XVIIth/ beginning XVIIIth century.
