Pair of large decorative elements in natural oak wood representing knotted ropes emerging from an acanthus leaf. Some will see a marine work, others an element of masonic temple decor "knot rope", in speculative Freemasonry, the rope goes around the Temple, starting from the north, passing through the east, at noon, to return to the south column and close the temple by framing the door; it is placed at the limit of the starry vault, the link between heaven and earth, between Zenith and Nadir. It is the enclosure of the temple. It protects the profane world Work of the end XVIII. Good condition, large size, very decorative.
