Very large full-length portrait signed Alice Kaub Casalongua exhibited at the salon of French artists in 1901 (see stamp on the back) - (1875 -Paris 1948) - Canvas entitled "Family Portrait" so a relative of this one -

To Kaub Casalonga was a close to Berthe Morisot and a feminist before the time, she actively participated in the feminist newspaper "La Française" initiated by the famous American journalist Jane Misme -

Elève de Bouguereau, and Ferrier she developed a dreamlike universe in some of these paintings -

Without knowing her career path I went to this determined woman who had to af to face acerbic criticism -

A woman painter at the time was qualified as aliènè as was Berthe Morisot however married and supported by Eugéne Manet - An elderly woman whose sweetness wisdom simplicity touched me, everything converges towards this beautiful face, just a letter a vase in the shade on the table punctuate the canvas -Splendid frame with braid of oak leaves and tassels gilded with leaf -
