Rouen earthenware shaker. Period late 17th / early 18th. Cylindrical in shape (the oldest form, without pedestal) it is divided into two parts. The dome decorated day cover is screwed onto the body with a pewter screw thread. The decor is in shades of blue with a big fire. Patterns of foliage, garlands, lambrequins and flowers typical of the production of Rouen at this period. The finesse of execution is to be emphasized. An object of luxury in its time, it was used to sprinkle the sugar which had to be crushed and grated beforehand. All dishes, even meats, were often sweet. To report a chip at the bottom of the base.
