He first practices drawing. Representing imaginary subjects and staging more or less monstrous characters drawn in a realistic manner. From 1974 to 1975 he studied wood carving at the School of Fine Arts in Paris; but this technique does not meet his expectations. He also does a bit of acrylic and oil painting but his big revelation was the discovery of watercolor in 1983 "Whereas before I considered it a minor technique, it quickly caught my attention".
