High quality work, characteristic of Maison Millet in Paris. Cipolin marble is a variety of marble used by the Romans. At the end of the reign of Louis XVI, there is a craze for this type of minerals with thick green wavy ribs, tending to blue and crossed by thick layers of white mica. We know the success of the porphyry of Egypt, the marbles of Italy, the jasper, the agate, the malachite, the lapis lazuli, or the cipolin in the manufacture of mounted objects.
