Description

Commode Mazarine au Jasmin Louis XIV style, according to the models of Thomas Hache, in precious wood veneer, entirely inlaid on the tray, the facade and the sides with decorations of bouquets of flowers, interlaced leaves, vases, scrolls and jasmine flowers in bone petals. It opens with three drawers in faceted cabochons, the uprights are with baluster consoles. Beautiful ornamentation of golden bronzes with tilting handles and tray set with an ingot mold. It is a very beautiful piece of furniture of inspiration, which has nothing to envy to the fabrications of the Atelier des Hache, the marquetry is perfect, the frame and the drawers are of traditional manufacture. The buffer varnish was redone by our cabinetmaker. Very beautiful work as we still knew how to do it in the 19th century.
