Boule marquetry was born in the 17th century under Louis XIV and owes its name to André-Charles Boulle, master cabinetmaker at the King's court. Marquetry consists of placing precious materials inside precious wood such as tortoiseshell, copper, mother-of-pearl, brass ... The most worked precious woods were ebony, pear, rosewood, sandalwood, elm, cherry, mahogany...
