Diameter of the work: 4 cm Diameter of the frame: 8.5 cm Napoleon François Joseph Charles Bonaparte, prince imperial, king of Rome, born March 20, 1811 at the Tuileries Palace, in Paris, and died July 22, 1832 at the palace de Schönbrunn, in Vienna, is the son and heir of Napoleon I, Emperor of the French, and his second wife, Marie-Louise of Austria.
