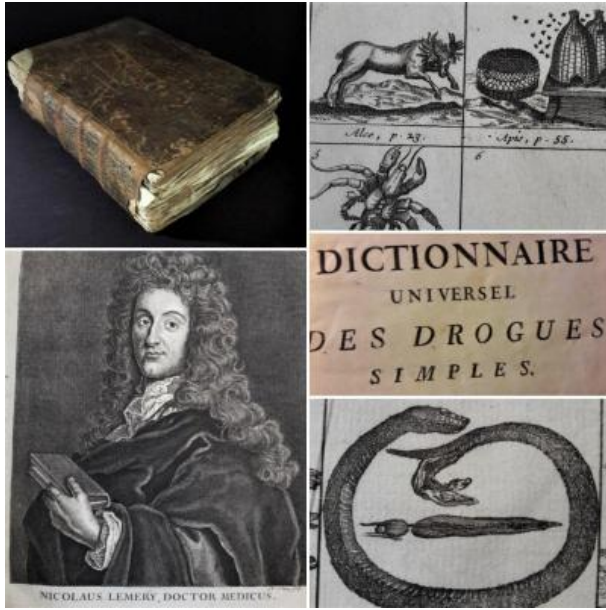

It contains the description of drugs, their virtues, the choice to be made, their history. " Associate chemist at the Academy from 1699, Nicolas Lémery wrote his Treaty of Antimony in 1707 and died on June 19, 1715 of a stroke. The dictionary begins letter A with Abelicea, false Sandalwood from Candia, and ends with Zopissa, cooked pitch, resolving and desiccating which mariners use to tarring or plugging the joints of their ships.
