It has a molded mahogany wood structure with four curved legs and goat feet. A light crossbar joins the four legs giving elegance and stability. The oval top is made of marble called Alabastro fiorito. The fine wood essence of mahogany has a dark finish that gives refinement and gracefulness and is aimed at simulating another valuable wood, such as ebony. This furniture has a rather rare compositional line and is suitable to be used as a center table, placed between two sofas or armchairs or near a wall in any room of your home, a living room, an
