Beautiful oval table with flaps in solid mahogany. It opens in the central part, a set of slides allowing the installation of extensions. The top is molded with a double torus. It rests on 6 turned mahogany feet carved with strong gadroons, punctuated by moldings, rings and flattened balls, terminated by brass shoes and wooden wheels.

Open: 140 x 160 cm.

Shutters folded down: 160 x 72 cm.

2 large extensions (160 x 50 cm each) and a small one (160 x 25 cm) in oak are provided. This table also makes it possible to deploy up to
