Probably intended for a somewhat bulky sagemono (tonkotsu, or Kiseru), due to its weight, despite the small object in hand. Very curious netsuke, in bronze, representing a child playing ball, lying down, entirely lacquered in black. Himotoshi (passage of the silk cord) is done with outstretched arms. Excellent condition, no flaws, no break, it will just need to be cleaned! Japanese working, dating from the second half of the 19th century, Meiji period, genuine item! Dimensions: 4cm x 2.2cm x 2cm
