Henri Edmond CROSS Pastel Seaside very bright pastel of an animated Mediterranean coast 16 x 22 cm signed lower left of the stamp this one is very faded, almost invisible to the eye without Wood's lamp we attach the photo of the 'work, with the certificate of authenticity of M $^\circ$ Chassaing on the back Sale of November 29, 1995 Toulouse The French painter Henri Edmond Cross (1856-1910), whose real name is Henri Joseph Edmond Delacroix, is one of the precursors of the Neo -impressionism with Georges Seurat and Paul Signac, based on the optical division of color, according to the principles of pointillism and divisionism. His work is also essential in the development of avant-garde movements, notably Fauvism, through the figure of Henri Matisse, and cubism.
